OneSource provides education, access, and treatment support for people living with paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria (PNH) and their caregivers. It is staffed by Alexion Nurse Case Managers, who are registered nurses with healthcare and insurance experience. Alexion Pharmaceuticals developed this program to help patients obtain access to Soliris®, and provide them with reliable information on PNH and Soliris.

What a Nurse Case Manager can do for you.

Alexion Nurse Case Managers provide support by:

Education

- Collaborating with you and your healthcare providers, answering questions, and providing educational resources related to PNH and Soliris®
- Providing information before your first infusion so you know exactly what to expect

Access

- Helping you navigate insurance issues and coordinating other needs that are important to your treatment plan
 - For example: providing information on insurance verifications, coverage determinations, and, if necessary, assistance in securing alternative funding



Alexion's goal is to ensure that all patients who may benefit from Soliris will have access to it.

Treatment Support

- Answering questions about treatment with Soliris
- Assisting with solutions for maintaining therapy if there is a major life event, such as a change in family, job, provider, or insurance status
- Helping to find alternate infusion sites based on your travel needs

WARNING: SERIOUS MENINGOCOCCAL INFECTIONS

Soliris increases the risk of meningococcal infections. Meningococcal infection may become rapidly life-threatening or fatal if not recognized and treated early
